## Vision and hearing benefits for adults are new in 2022.



#### Adults age 21 and older now have a:

**Vision benefit:** Includes annual exam with \$0 copay. Also includes contact lenses or clear plastic prescription lenses in select frames.

For help finding an eye doctor where you live, call Member Services at 1-844-325-6251, Monday–Friday, 8 a.m.–8 p.m., or search the Provider Directory.

**Hearing benefit:** Includes routine hearing exam with \$0 copay and one hearing aid for each ear every 2 calendar years, as needed, through the TruHearing program. Also includes ear molds and fittings, 60day trial period, 1-year supply of batteries, and 3-year manufacturer's warranty for repairs and maintenance.

Call 1-877-759-3272 to talk with a hearing consultant and schedule your appointment.

**Note:** For children age 20 and younger, Highmark Health Options covers:

- Eye exams and eyeglasses or contacts (some limitations apply)
- Hearing exams, hearing aids, and batteries

These standard benefits for children are not new.



## Smile! Dental care can make your mouth happy.



Highmark Health Options covers dental care for adults age 21 and older. Take advantage of coverage that lets you correct dental problems now and prevent new ones in the future.

You have \$1,000 coverage each year for dental care, and more coverage may be approved if you need emergency dental care. Your copay is currently waived during the Delaware public health emergency. And you don't need a referral to see a dentist.

#### **Dental benefits include:**

- Routine Cleanings
- Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery
- Periodontics
- Preventive Services
- Denture Repairs and Relines
- Restorative Services
- Testing and Exams
- X-rays

#### Dental benefits do not include:

- Dentures
- Removal of bony and impacted wisdom teeth

**Note:** For children age 20 and younger, dental is covered by the State, excluding removal of bony impacted wisdom teeth. Removal of bony impacted wisdom teeth is covered under the Highmark Health Options medical benefit.



## Now get a 90-day supply for some medicines.



You may be able to get a 90-day supply of your medicine instead of a 30-day supply. This means you only need to refill your prescription four times a year.

#### Talk to your doctor about a 90-day supply.

The medicines covered by this benefit treat ongoing conditions like asthma, depression, high cholesterol, high blood pressure, and more. Covered medicines are listed below. The list includes brand and generic names. Look on your prescription bottle for either the brand or generic name.

If you take one of these medicines, ask your doctor if a 90-day prescription is right for you. If so, your doctor can write the prescription for 90 days. And you can pick up your medicine at your retail pharmacy.

If you don't have type 2 diabetes and want to prevent it, this program is for you. Highmark Health Options has partnered with the YMCA of Delaware to offer the Diabetes Prevention Program. The program lasts for one year and includes 25 one-hour group sessions. If you're eligible and age 18 or older, you may be able to join this free program.

A trained Lifestyle Coach leads small group sessions to help participants:

#### Statement of Members' Rights and Responsibilities.

The organization's member rights and responsibilities statement specifies that members have:

- 1. A right to receive information about the organization, its services, its practitioners and providers and member rights and responsibilities.
- 2. A right to be treated with respect and recognition of their dignity and their right to privacy.
- 3. A right to participate with practitioners in making decisions about their health care.
- 4. A right to a candid discussion of appropriate or medically necessary treatment options for their conditions, regardless of cost or benefit coverage.
- 5. A right to voice complaints or appeals about the organization or the care it provides.

- 6. A right to make recommendations regarding the organization's member rights and responsibilities policy.
- 7. A responsibility to supply information (to the extent possible) that the organization and its practitioners and providers need in order to provide care.
- 8. A responsibility to follow plans and instructions for care that they have agreed to with their practitioners.
- 9. A responsibility to understand their health problems and participate in developing mutually agreed-upon treatment goals, to the degree possible.
