

Prescription Drug Copays

Highmark Health Options charges copays for prescription drugs you fill at the pharmacy. Your copay is the money you need to pay at the time of service.

Your copay is based on the cost of each prescription.

Prescription Cost	Your Copay*
\$10 or less	50 cents
\$10.01-\$25	\$1
\$25.01-\$50	\$2
\$50.01 and above	\$3

*Copays will resume Dec. 1, 2023.

The most you will pay for prescription copays every 30 days is \$15. Once you meet the \$15 copay maximum for the 30 days, you will pay zero copays for drugs filled for the rest of the month. This copay maximum will start over every 30 days.

There are no copays for prescriptions for:

- Birth control
- Buprenorphine, buprenorphine/naloxone, and vivitrol for opioid use disorder
- Naloxone (Narcan®) for opioid overdose
- Stop-smoking medicines

There are no copays for:

- Children under age 21
- People in the Chronic Renal Disease program
- People in hospice care
- Some people in a long-term care facility
- Pregnant women (including up to 1 year after the end of the pregnancy)
