DEFINITIONS

Highmark Health Options (HHO) – Managed care organization serving vulnerable populations that have complex needs and qualify for Medicaid. Highmark Health Options members include individuals and families with low income, expecting mothers, children, and people with disabilities. Members pay nothing to very little for their health coverage. Highmark Health Options currently services Delaware Medicaid: Delaware Healthy Children Program (DHCP) and Diamond State Health Plan Plus members.

Pelvic congestion syndrome (PCS also known as pelvic venous incompetence [PVI]) – A condition that has been present for greater than six (6) months with anatomic findings that include pelvic venous insufficiency and pelvic varicosities.
