



Provider orientation sessions for musculoskeletal services requiring prior authorization.

Effective Nov. 1, 2021, Medicaid patients receiving the musculoskeletal services listed below will require prior authorization:

- Interventional pain management
- Joint surgery
- Spine surgery

Beginning Oct. 15, eviCore healthcare will offer online orientation sessions designed to assist providers and their staff with the new programs. These sessions will provide:

- Information about the prior authorization process.
- Instructions on how to access information from the eviCore website.

- 6. Enter registration information.
